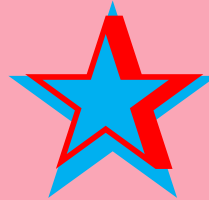

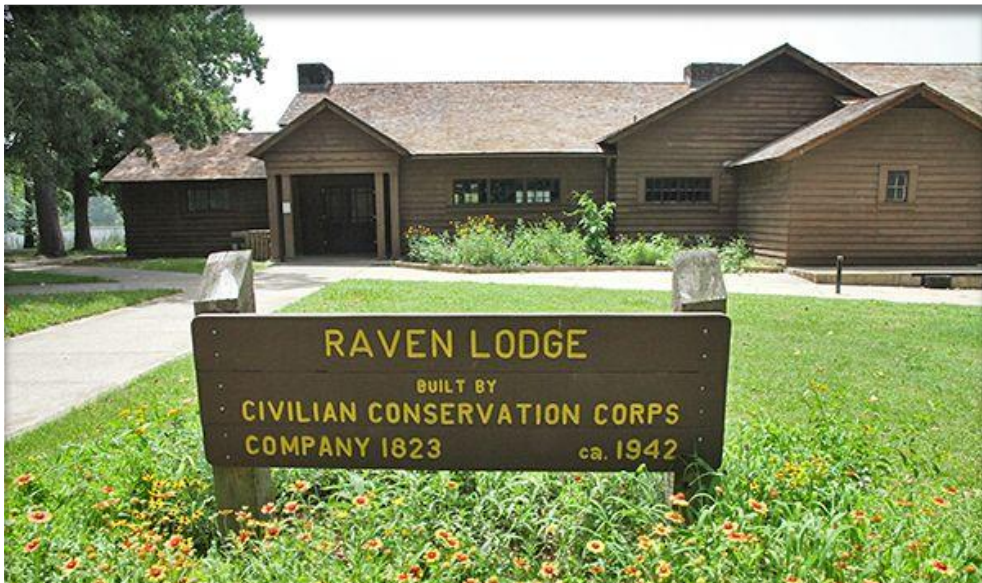

Cacher of the Month

Southeast Texas - TxGo4Fan

TXGA: Tell us a little about yourself. Here are “Two Truths and a Fib” about Paul Nagel: I was born outside of Chicago, grew up a Cubs fan, moved to Minnesota, and became a Twins and Gophers fan. I have flown around the world and have been to Challenger Deep - the bottom of the Marianas Trench. I am a season ticket holder for the University of Texas Longhorns. As a teacher, I often receive questions from my students. Can you guess which statement is incorrect? Ask me at the next CITO.

TXGA: How did you get started geocaching? In April 2007, I responded to an email from the Geological Society of America inviting me to a workshop about Earthcaches in Boulder, Colorado. I was one of twenty teachers who learned about Earthcaches from Gary Lewis, the “Father of Earthcaches.” One of the tasks at the workshop involved creating an Earthcache. I developed “40 Acres” (GC17CDF) on November 11, 2007, encouraging geocachers to reflect on how humans modify and adapt to the world around us. Fast forward to January 2013, when my wife and daughters went on a Girl Scouts trip, and my youngest returned to share this exciting game - Geocaching. My wife added, “I think you will like it, Paul.” I still wasn't convinced, but at an education conference in New Orleans, I met a fellow teacher, David, aka Faerbers, who told me how he would print the description of the cache, print pictures, and try to find the container. That did not sound like fun at all. However, with my wife's encouragement again, I was hooked.

TXGA: How did you come up with your caching name? In 2007, when I created “40 Acres,” I had to establish an account with Ground Speak. I graduated from the University of Minnesota, where their mascot is the Golden Gophers. I chose the combination of Texas and Minnesota – txgo4fan.

TXGA: What do you enjoy most about geocaching? The best part of geocaching is that it gets my daughters and me outside. My daughters love exploring new places. Living in Texas, there are 254 unique counties to discover and explore.

TXGA: What are some highlights of your geocaching career so far? I took my oldest daughter, Sweet Thing, to Palau, where we discovered “Jellyfish Lake” (GC11A56), where my daughter and I could swim with jellyfish that evolved without stingers. During that trip, I also found caches in Guam and Hawai'i. A highlight in Texas was climbing Guadalupe Peak and finding GC4EEF with my youngest daughter, Buddy598.

TXGA: What else would you like to share? As part of a Girl Scouts badge, Buddy598 asked one day if we could hold a CITO to give back to the community. That first CITO took place in April 2016. Since then, Buddy598 and I have organized 108 consecutive monthly CITOs in Southeast Texas, along with several in Port Aransas and for Earth Day (GCB2JKM) each year. In addition to the CITOs, I have ten Earthcaches in Port Aransas.

Our cache this month comes from the South region: GCAJJ2B. It's called "Bloom", a virtual cache placed by Paper_Moon.

This simple, yet delightful cache is a "must visit" for several reasons: It is easily accessible at a trailhead and one can enjoy a walk down the trail, if you like. The art is fun, and the cache owner has encouraged the finders to be creative with their photo logs. If you have time to review the photos, folks are taking the creativity seriously! I really love that we not only get to see the cool artwork, but learn about and celebrate a local artist.

To make this stop even more fun and interesting, there is also an Adventure Lab about the art and artist you can do while you are there!

"Bloom" by San Antonio artist Leticia Huerta is a permanent public artwork located at Tezel Road City Facility. Inspired by trail users and nearby native flora, Huerta created the original "Bloom" installation at McAllister Park. This particular installation is at Culebra Creek Tributary Tezel Trailhead. The Engelmann Daisy and Ironweed can be seen here, while other "Bloom" flowers are "planted" along the Howard Peak Green Way Trail System across San Antonio.

The expanded "Bloom" series sees indigenous wildflowers turned into sculptures with components that resemble larger-than-life bicycle parts. I can't wait to find the other flowers.

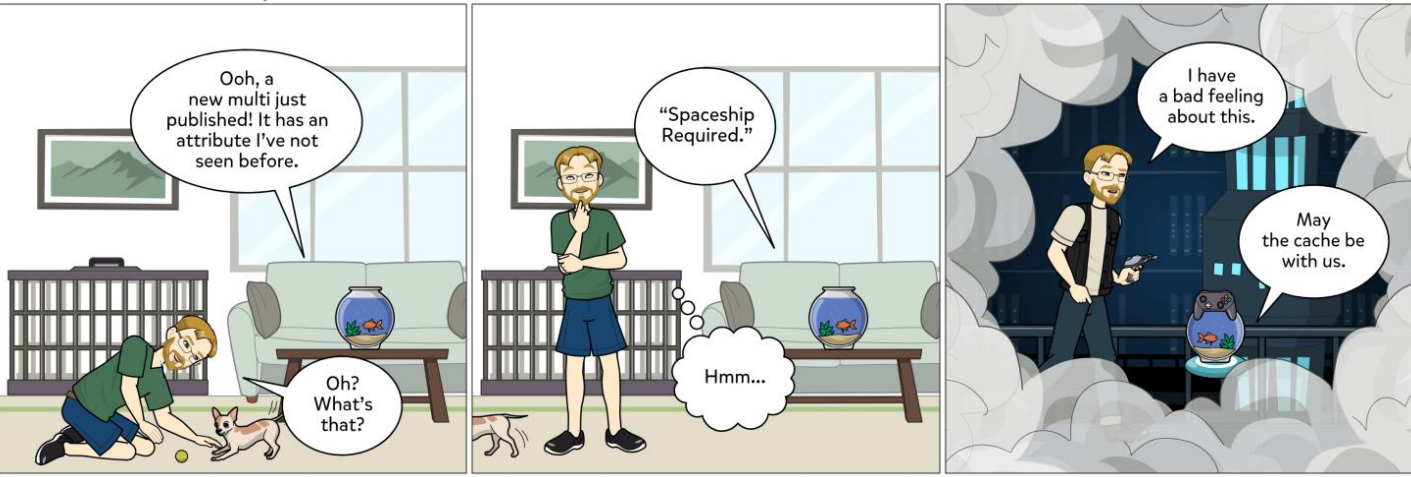
