## Story **Board**

What's your idea of a Geocaching Adventure? Finding that certain target geocache? Finding all that are on your list for the outing? Just spending the day with friends can become a geocaching adventure, and believe it or not, some of the most memorable geocaching adventures don't even involve finding the geocache. Or at least it seems that way to me.

Most of my geocaching adventures happen when I'm alone, on the road toward a distant location. A couple years ago, I left Tatum in mid-May, headed toward Sioux Falls, with a few targets on my list.

Here's my log for one of my two Colorado targets:

"This was an adventure, worthy of a favorite point. I made the drive up from Raton, on the way to Cheyenne. My driving direction app led me to the wrong way up here, so I had to do a manual override to get to the right forestry service road. I left the highway and started my ascent.

I met a couple vehicles not too far from the highway, so I had no concerns about having issues on the road to the pass. I saw snow on the sides of the road, but kept going upward. There were a couple of spots with snow covering the road, but there was a set of tracks through it, so I pressed on. I rounded a curve and saw that there was snow all over the road as far as I could see, but the tracks gave me the idea that I could make it. I kept going and made it to about 1000 feet from the pass, then all progress came to a stop. The 8 or so inches of snow was too much for my highway tires and two-wheel drive. I was stuck in the snow.

I spent about an hour and a half digging out of the snow and easing my way back down the road, trying to get to that one spot where I could turn around. My Texas bravado gave me the idea that I could walk the rest of the way, but my time in Scouting slapped me with the reality of being unprepared to hike through the snow for this cache. Shorts and sneakers are not suitable for this terrain. Maybe I'll be back again, in a warmer time of the year. Thanks for the adventure. Today is Day Three of my epic journey that will take me through fifteen states on my roundabout tour to pick up my son in Sioux Falls on the way to meet some friends to watch the Indy 500. ..."

Yeah, it was a DNF for that cache, but what an adventure! I spent well over an hour digging the snow from around the tires, using a broken 3 iron and a short piece of board. I really wanted to go for that cache, but I just couldn't risk it. After that experience, I try to keep extra shoes and long pants in my truck, just in case.

This is in my Top 5 Geocaching Adventures, maybe even Top 3, so far! What's your favorite geocaching adventure? It might just be your next one, so keep going out there!

#### TXGA: Tell us a little about yourself.

I'm a social worker and have been at my job for eighteen years. I like being able to help others. I've got a passion for working with individuals with developmental disabilities and I used to care for a person with developmental disabilities in our home. If I'm not working or spending time with my family, then I'm playing with our dogs. We started fostering dogs two years ago and always have an extra baby until a home is found for them.

#### TXGA: How did you get started caching?

I've been geocaching since 2010. I had never heard of geocaching until I met Fire2Water. He told me on our first date we had to stop and get a cache. I wondered what we were actually going to get at the dark park when we pulled up. We found a magnetic key holder under the park bench, and I still didn't fully understand what geocaching was at the time. It wasn't too long later that we were out driving through the woods grabbing caches. Geocaching quickly became something we'd do together when we were off.

**TXGA:** How did you come up with your caching name? Well, anyone that has seen me knows that I'm extra fluffy so that basically sums up how I got my caching name.

TXGA: What do you most enjoy about geocaching?

There's so many things that I like about caching. I love the time my family and I spend together. I've enjoyed meeting new friends and visiting new places geocaching has taken me.

### TXGA: What are some highlights of your geocaching career so far?

I participated in my first Texas Challenge in 2016 and had a blast. The next year it was our time to host the Challenge. I spent countless hours driving around while Fire2Water hid caches. The 2017 challenge year gave me a good perspective of what it takes to put one together and I appreciate all the hard work everyone puts into them. I think the biggest personal highlight for me is me walking up to a vendor at Geowoodstock in 2019 and asking if they could put a pathtag on a shirt for me Fire2Water had a design but hadn't made the tags yet. MonsterBebe and I got the joy of giving Fire2Water his pathtag shirt for Father's day that year. It was a priceless moment. Now when I see pathtag shirts on other cachers, I smile and think to myself I helped start that idea.

#### TXGA: What else would you like to share?

I like completing the different geotours. I've started trying to log as we cache but if I ever log one you've hidden super late from the date I found it just know life got busy and I didn't get it logged. One day when life slows down, I want to complete the county challenge. I drive my car in Challenge like someone stole it! So, it's always a get in and hold on moment. If you ever see someone driving like they don't have good sense in Challenge just smile and wave cause we're on a mission to get those nunches.
